ABOUT THE CANADIAN OPEN MATHEMATICS CHALLENGE (COMC)

COMC is Canada's premier national mathematics competition open to any student with an interest in mathematics and problem solving. Every year some 7000 students from Canada and all around the world take part in the competition. The competition is organised by the Canadian Mathematical Society (CMS) and has an 11-year success record. The problems are conceptualised by the CMS's Competition Committee which consists of experienced mathematicians and math educators and the exams are marked by mathematicians and graduate students at reputable universities, through Crowdmark, which was originally founded to respond to the COMC's grading needs.

Target Group

While any student under 18 can take part in the competition, the questions are designed for students in grade 10 and above.

Outreach

The COMC is advertised on CMS Social Media Pages and Publications. The CMS also advertises the competition to teachers association across Canada and sends invitation letters to school principals and math teachers to register their students.

Starting in 2020, the CMS will invite 200 Black and Indigenous students to write the competition free of cost.

GOALS

For Sponsors and Organisers

The purpose of the COMC is to encourage students to explore, discover, and learn more about mathematics and problem solving. The analytical skills that students gain through mathematics education is foundational in many STEM fields and pivotal in a successful career in STEM.

The competition also serves to provide teachers with a unique student enrichment activity during the fall term. The CMS provides both students and teachers with a series of weekly problems and solutions in the 9 weeks that precede the date of the competition.

For Students

Top-ranking students will be invited to write the Canadian Mathematical Olympiad and have a chance, upon writing the national Olympiad, to be invited to the National Training Camp and selected to the Math Team Canada, participating at the International Mathematical Olympiad (IMO).

Other students will also be awarded various participation prizes and increase their chances of obtaining University entrance scholarships through our university partners.
